

Preface


The "Statistical Guide" provides data on the continuous further development and quality assurance of our educational system and thus helps to support present discussions on educational policies at an objective level.







Chart 4.1: Proportion of female students in the various fields of study of intermediate technical and vocational schools, school year 2011/12









Chart 4.2: Proportion of female students in the various fields of study of higher technical and vocational colleges, school year 2011/12







Proportion of school types at grade 10 school year 2011/12





Transitions from 4th grades of General secondary schools and Academic secondary schools, lower level, school year 2011/12


