

A small reminder:

Demonstrative pronouns point out how close a person/animal/thing is to the speaker.

"Near in time" is expressed with this/ these, "further away in time" is expressed with that/ those.

We use

	Singular	Plural
.	<u>this</u> = <i>dieser/ diese/ dieses</i>	<u>these</u> = diese
	<u>that</u> = jener/jene/jenes	<u>those</u> = jene

There are also some phrases with demonstrative pronouns that are often used:

- in those days/ at that time one of these days That's right. That's wrong. That's just not done. That's a good idea.
- in this day and age/ these days heutzutage, in der heutigen Zeit, jetzt ... damals, früher ... eines Tages ... Das ist richtig. Das ist in Ordnung. ... Das ist nicht richtig. Das ist falsch.
 - ... Das tut man nicht.
 - ... Das ist eine gute Idee.
